



COMPETITION RULES

- Please make sure your routines & costumes are age-appropriate and that you avoid subjects that could be contentious, or that could be sensitive to our younger audiences. Please ask the office if you are in any doubt.
- Unless otherwise agreed with management, you can enter a maximum of 4 groups – Minis/Juniors/Seniors and College. If you have a group with mixed ages you should calculate the age category by adding ages up and dividing by the number of performers.
- Please note, in 2023 the competition season is for dance schools, however educational schools & colleges that offer A level/BTEC/Degree/Diploma courses are allowed to enter up to the age of 21.
- Any schools that bring dancers not in the correct age within their group will be disqualified. LDL reserves the right to do spot checks on ages at the events.
- The Minimum group size is 4 PEOPLE, with a maximum of 30.
- Routines should be a maximum of 2.5 minutes long unless otherwise agreed upon by Management. (Any music over 2.5 minutes will be returned and asked to be cut, 5 points will be lost in the competition for every 10 seconds over the 2.5-minute mark). All music must be sent to us at least 2 weeks prior to the event. You will be emailed a link to upload your tracks & once this has been uploaded it cannot be changed.
- Places for every convention will be issued on a first come first served basis.

- We welcome costumes however if the stage is littered after your performance with feathers, confetti, petals etc, you should be prepared to remove it after your routine. No form of liquid, gel, aerosol, or glitter may be used that could affect the dancing surface. No helium balloons can be used.
- LDL staff are not responsible for any props or costumes.
- LDL is a professional platform for you to compete with your dance school/group. Adjudication Categories include choreography, technique, presentation and performance.
- Each school must have a DBS-checked, named representative responsible for the conduct of the children throughout the convention. You must bring your own chaperones & helpers, please ensure they carry their chaperone & DBS certificates with them.
- The performance schedule will be sent out approximately 5 to 7 days prior to the event.
- Dancers take part at their own risk. LDL will not be held responsible for any injury that may be sustained during any of our conventions. Schools must ensure that all tricks and movements performed by their dancers are appropriate to each dancer's ability.
- LDL reserve the right to use any photographs or footage for advertising and marketing purposes.
- LDL reserve the right to refuse entries. Bad sportsmanship will result in your group being disqualified at our discretion.
- LDL is a friendly, positive and supportive event and we expect schools to support and inspire one another, please always clap your fellow schools & encourage them to do well. Please contact us with any further questions you may have.

PURCHASING YOUR REGIONAL TICKET

The purchase of a Regional ticket is subject to availability and subject to acceptance by LoveDanceLive. We use our best efforts to ensure that the prices of the Regional tickets displayed are correct. It is always possible that, despite our best efforts, some Regional tickets on our site may be incorrectly priced. If we discover an error in the price of a Regional ticket you have ordered, we will contact you to inform you of this error. You will have the option of continuing with the purchase at the correct price or cancelling your order. If we are unable to contact you using the contact details provided during the order process, we will treat the order as cancelled and notify you of the cancellation. Age restrictions apply to the Regionals. Please note that where age restrictions apply, you book accordingly. We reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who is, or appears to be, under or over the applicable age. If we suspect that your Regional ticket has been purchased fraudulently, we may cancel your booking.

RESELLING YOUR REGIONAL TICKET

Regional tickets sold or being offered for sale for commercial gain or profit is strictly prohibited and we reserve the right to cancel your booking and refuse entry to the event. You may resell your ticket for the same price to another dancer as long as they are in the same age category.

REQUESTING REFUNDS

Regional tickets cannot be refunded after purchase. If for any reason you can no longer attend the Regional event you have purchased a ticket for, you may have the option to transfer onto another Regional event of the same value, this is subject to availability and subject to acceptance by LoveDanceLive

CANCELLATION, POSTPONEMENT OR CHANGES TO YOUR REGIONAL EVENT

In the occurrence that an event is changed, postponed or cancelled, it is your responsibility to check that the event is going ahead as advertised. All advertised times are approximate and subject to change. If your event is postponed, your Regional ticket will be valid for the rescheduled date and you have the following options: Attend your rescheduled LDL Regional Transfer to another LDL Regional Convention Transfer your tickets over to an LDL Regional 2023 Request a refund if none of the above options are suitable, please note – All Payments are made one month before the event date. A refund must be requested at least one month/28 days prior to the date of the competition you are booked into. Personal arrangements including travel, subsistence and accommodation relating to the event which have been arranged by you are at your own risk.
